Today, cities cover only 2% of the world's land area, yet they are estimated to consume about 60-80% of the world's energy and emit about 75% of carbon dioxide in the world through their economic and social activities.



The cluster strategy <u>"MACHIZUKURI"</u> aims to solve urban issues by <u>citizen participation</u> and <u>citizen-led initiatives</u>, <u>public-private partnerships</u>, <u>improvement of administrative capacity</u> to support local communities, and to increase the number of sustainable cities that can realize and continue green, resilient, and inclusive urban development through the appropriate <u>utilization of new technologies such as digital technology</u>.



Purpose:

To strengthen the capacity for comprehensive planning and management of urban transport in Phnom Penh Capital City.

Outputs:

1. Under the lead of PPCA, PPUTMP is updated based on a process of discussion, examination, and consensus building across multiple related organizations.

2. Through the practice of pilot projects for short-term measures, in which collaboration among multiple organizations is essential, the ability to implement cross-sectoral projects in urban transport is enhanced.

3. Organizational structure for public transportation management and operation is strengthened.

#### Background:


Lack of regulations and management of land use and construction permission based on LUP supported by JICA in 2011. Low awareness of LUP among people and business.

Purpose:

To strengthen the management capacity of urban development and land use along with LUP, by using Digital Technologies Outputs:

- 1. Improvement of construction permission based on LUP, by using GIS platform
- 2. Enhanced awareness of LUP among people and business by using GIS platform as a communication tool
- 3. Strengthened management mechanism for urban development with citizen participation

Control by Construction Permission, development guidance by project planning, Land Use Planning promoting the improvement of the city by involvement of people and business




Fig. JICA Major Project : Development Study- Major Projects of Urban Master Plan
